



NOTICE WRIT OF ELECTION Kwanlin Dün First Nation

Regular Election for the Chief and Six Councillors
Wednesday, March 15, 2023

Criteria for Chief and Councillor Candidates:

- is enrolled as a citizen;
- is 18 years of age or older on the voting date;
- declares that he or she will ordinarily reside in the traditional territory of the Kwanlin Dün First Nation for the entire term of his or her office;
- pursuant to subsection 22(4) of the constitution, has not been finally convicted of an indictable offense under the Criminal Code of Canada within three years immediately before the closing date for nominations;
- has at least 25 eligible voters sign a prescribed nomination form in support of his or her candidacy; and
- does not hold office as a city councillor, member of the Yukon Legislative Assembly or member of the Senate or the House of Commons of Canada or similar elected body;
- has not been found to have engaged in a corrupt practice in connection with an election within the last six years; and,
- delivers signed and completed in full the necessary nomination forms by the close of nomination as prescribed by section 44 of the Election Act

Nomination Packages are available at the KDFN Election Office - #4 O'Brien Place
Nomination Forms must be submitted to the Chief Returning Officer (CRO) before

Close of Nominations: 4 p.m. on Wednesday, February 1, 2023

KDFN Citizens who are 18 years of age or older as of the Voting Day are eligible to vote.

In addition to the Voting Day Poll, the following voting methods will be used in this election:

- **ADVANCE VOTE** – see details below
- **MAIL-IN VOTE** – mail-in voting packages will be mailed no later than February 10, 2023 to every eligible Citizen who resides outside the Traditional Territory of the Kwanlin Dun First Nation.
- **SPECIAL VOTE** – any voter may apply for a special ballot on the prescribed form to the Chief Returning Officer.
